My life was falling apart when I attended my first AA meeting, but I wasn't willing to listen to anything that was suggested to me. I remember going to FYCPAA when Space Coast hosted it and isolating myself the entire day. The person that brought me told me I need to be a part of to feel a part of, but I didn't want to be there or be sober. It took a few more years of bouncing in and out of meetings before I finally surrendered and gave the program an honest try.

I got involved in service early in my recovery and was making coffee and cookies for the 909 Sober Time Young People's group. Serving the coffee forced me to get to know people and I couldn't hide in the back and sneak out early anymore. I finally started to feel a part of AA when I got involved and contributed to the meetings I was attending. My sponsor and friends would always encourage me to reach out to another alcoholic or find some service work when I had thoughts of drinking in my first year, and it always worked! I've been blessed to learn many different positions at my home group, serve as our Intergroup and District Treasurer, and now I serve as Area 14's Parliamentarian.
